Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were <u>edified</u>; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

Romans 14:19 Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may <u>edify</u> another.

1 Corinthians 8:1 Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity <u>edifieth</u>.

1 Corinthians 10:23 All things are lawful for me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but all things <u>edify</u> not.

1 Corinthians 14:4 He that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue <u>edifieth</u> himself; but he that prophesieth <u>edifieth</u> the church.

1 Corinthians 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater *is* he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive <u>edifying</u>.

1 Corinthians 14:12 Even so ye, forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual *gifts*, seek that ye may excel to the **<u>edifying</u>** of the church.

1 Corinthians 14:17 For thou verily givest thanks well, but the other is not <u>edified</u>.

1 Corinthians 14:26 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto **<u>edifying</u>**.

2 Corinthians 12:19 Again, think ye that we excuse ourselves unto you? we speak before God in Christ: but *we do* all things, dearly beloved, for your **edifying**.

Ephesians 4:12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry,

for the **<u>edifying</u>** of the body of Christ:

Ephesians 4:16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the **edifying** of itself in love.

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of <u>edifying</u>, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and <u>edify</u> one another, even as also ye do.

1 Timothy 1:4 Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly **<u>edifying</u>** which is in faith: *so do*.
