Text - Isa. 57:15

Intro. - There is perhaps no greater prophet of the OT than Isaiah. His name means "Jehovah is Salvation."

- He is the greatest of the "writing" prophets.
- He is quoted more in the NT than all other prophets combined.
- Prophesied primarily to Judah; ministered for 50+ yrs. (over ~~30~~ <sup>85</sup> times)
- His life spanned the reigns of 4 kings of Judah: Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah

- \* His writings picture the Lord: \* Lifted on the Throne <sup>ch. 6</sup> \* Lifted on the Cross <sup>ch. 53</sup>
- \* His favorite name for the Lord is the "Holy One of Israel." (Isa. 53) (25 times)

- His book much like the Bible itself:

Bible	Isaiah
66 books	66 ch.
OT - 39 Law	1st section - 39 Law
NT - 27 Gospels	2nd section - 27 Gospels

→ Virgin Birth - 7:14  
 • Sacrifice on Calvary - 53:1-6  
 • Future Kingdom - 59:20/60:18-21

\* Isa. 53 is the greatest OT passage on the Atonement of Christ!

\* Yet, with all that being said, Isaiah still has a heart/message for Revival.

✓ Holiness

1 - THE SOURCE - vs. 15 - "the high and lofty one" <sup>found only once in the Bible...</sup>  
"that inhabits eternity"  
"whose name is Holy"

✓ Humility

2 - THE SUBJECTS - vs. 15 - "him that is of a contrite and humble spirit"  
"the contrite ones"

✓ Help/Hope

3 - THE SEQUENCE - vs. 15 - 1st ~ God's Holiness  
2nd ~ Our Humbleness  
3rd ~ "To Revive"
